Archery

Archery Practices are held on Sunday from 10:00am to noon, and on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 5:30pm to 7:00pm. Loaner equipment and basic instruction are available. This is held as part of an Open Archery Practice through UCSD Recreation. There is a \$1.00 fee to use the facility. The UCSD Range has been temporarily relocated to the Torrey Pine Gliderport until approximately the end of summer 2011. Parking at the Gliderport site is free. From I-5 exit at Genesee Avenue westbound. At the top of the hill, turn left (south) on to North Torrey Pines Road. Continue two more traffic signals to Torrey Pines Scenic Drive and turn right (west). This is the street just before you reach the Salk Institute. On weekdays, drive about 300 yards and look for an open gate into overflow parking for Salk Institute staff. Turn right (north) and you'll see a fenced area with green netting on it straight ahead. This is the Archery range. On Sundays, the gate to Salk overflow parking is closed. Instead of turning here, continue westbound until you reach the cul-de-sac at the end of Torrey Pines Scenic Drive. There is a driveway here on to the dirt leading to the Gliderport building. Once you're on to the dirt curve to your right (east) and approach the range of the graded surface of the gliderport runway. Directions are available online at <http://archery.ucsd.edu/directions.html>. The range is the fenced outline just next to the 'CA84' marker on the aerial photo.

December 21, 2011

Baronial subgroup reports

Canton of Poll na Gainmhe (Lord Santiago): Meeting was held on 12/15. Cost of grounds use for anniversary and luncheon menu was discussed as well as adding a crochet and fabric/costume swap at event, Canton inventory and plans for a get together on New Years.

Canton of Tanwayour (Lady Ellyn): December's canton meeting was held at the usual place (Brother's Restaurant on Waring Road) at noon on Sunday December 4 but I was unable to attend due to a conflict with Kingdom Rapier Melee practice. There were four members in attendance; I believe all of them are officers. Our A&S officer Lady Sofia Sylvani has stepped down due to personal conflicts and her deputy Agnes Wurtman will be taking her position as soon as we're able to warrant her. Tanwayour sponsored an afternoon of sewing at the keep run by THL Eblenn an Ucaire on December 18. We're planning on doing these every two or three weeks but the details have not been decided upon. We will sort that out at one of the next sessions. Lady Sofia is planning on having a pewter casting workshop sometime in the spring to make tokens. Canton of Summergate (Sir Gaml): had meeting on 2nd Thurs--about 10 people. running regular fighter practices (6). Archery is dark because it's dark. bulk of meeting was discussing tourney. Friendship tourney March 10, 2012: Buddy Todd Park. Games and fighting. Theme is border raids. Perpetual story to be read at closing court. looking for someone to do a luncheon. pay for own provisions and keep what you make. will also put out to Gyldenholt. Have stewards to run. Guillaume will run a Pas.

Events

Calafia Anniversary (Sabina): almost made money, \$14 shy. No incidents on site. we are now award that there are parts of the park not available for archery. Champions in many categories. There were 66 at feast, 249 arts competitions, and contests. Lost and found to be held for ransom. We were off site very quickly and rangers were happy--by 6pm. One day event was good. Masonic hall was nice. Feast: asked chief lady and captain of the guard to help with clean up. then everyone saw them and got up and helped. Parking charges need to be addressed for next year--parking charges at county parks are becoming the norm. Nothing we can do about it. We are floating around a few ideas--we had 120 cars on site. Muirren: Thinking of doing a lump sum deal. It's negotiated into the contract for many years. Because we occupy so many areas, we didn't qualify for corp deal. No caution tape allowed in the park!

12th Night (Sabina): we will be requesting rugs because it's a concrete floor in a rodeo building. Put tape with name on it on the back. Will post to Calafia list. Accepting reservations for feast on web site. Need servers. No glass or stoneware outside--but can go on patio (can be in hall and in patio, but because it's a rodeo ground, nowhere else). Constables will be monitoring. Contests: Best personal heraldic presentations, and also table decorating contest with personal heraldry. Bard of Caid will be going on. Revel will follow the feast. Heaters outside for off board dining. Dancing by Thomas and live music Unusual consort. No drinking on site. Fundraising coffee bar and baked goods (taking contributions) to raise money for kingdom general fund. \$5 lunch available.

Baroness Brianna: 60% profit to kingdom and 40% host. 60% loss goes to host and 40% to kingdom. There is a possibility for 100% of money to go to kingdom. Last privy council; there was talk about kingdom being significantly in the hole. Not happy numbers. Currently solvent, but at the current burn rate, we have only 5-7 years.

Options: Oliver--we can make decision now or after event in January. Don't have to put \$\$ in general fund, could go in traveling fund. Thea--like idea of wait and see what the profits are. Discussion tabled until next month. Muirren--can give 70%. Fia: we haven't charged the kingdom for any losses.

Need clean-up crew.

Winter Weekend (Calafia) Fia: We're on. There might be snow? Check for food tonight. Fully booked.

Poll na Gainhme Anniversary: still hashing out the details

Old Business

Oliver/Kate: We still haven't done anything about getting a new baronial pavilion. No research for cost, or whether we need new poles. Need new ropes and stakes either new or reforged.

Fia: is there anyone in charge of doing this. We definitely need new canvas. Need cross beam; center poles that are carved will still work, but need more? Poles we have are of a certain height, but height needed varies with tent. Minimum dimensions needed. will set it up at Queen's champion. Panther is not the only vendor. Herald (Timothy) willing to take account of poles and what we have. Poles come in 6 or 7ft. We need 7 ft. Don't need sidewalls.

New Business

We have new pillow for kneeling and they are awesome. Old pillows (Thea wove fabric for old pillow and would like to repurpose the fabric). Needleworkers picked them up for refurbishment and was thinking of using at Potrero.

David: Angels getting new B&B soon. Presentation? For outgoing and new. Thea: Mistress Gabrielle needs new garb, not reigning as a couple. Suggest fabric.

Brianna: You may buy regalia with Baronial funds, but not personal items.

Donation to baronial coffers would be good (Thea). Queens Champion will have this elevation as well. Seraphina-- for stepping down, we can give largesse. Have something for Flavia.

Motion: Fia moves to gift a check for \$500 for Angels coffers. Passed.

Brianna--need to start plotting for what to do for Giuseppe and Giles stepping up. (Giles--back surgery on Jan 6).

Meeting adjourned 8:05.
